

 Linking with Government Schemes, Corpus Formation – Scalable and Replicable

 Community Mobilization, Beneficiary Contribution, Community Led Usage Monitoring, Emphasis on SHG's – Sustainable

- Usage by toilets at household level 91% and by <u>all adult members of</u> <u>Household at 95%</u>. <u>96 villages declared ODF</u> out of 418 project villages
- Sanitation Corpus created in over 255 Govt. schools through contribution, for sustainable operations & maintenance.
- School toilets being cleaned 1-3 times per week through Sanitation corpus, SMC / Panchayat contribution vis a vis no maintenance earlier.
