Objective: to develop and implement a concept for household sanitation, addressing the entire sanitation chain, that can be scaled-up countrywide/at national level



7 years programme (2011-2018)



US\$ 16.9 million from the Gates Foundation and the German Government through KFW with technical assistance from GIZ



Financed through Water Sector Trust Fund (WSTF)




